Change in Electronics Policy

Change in our electronic device policy: Parents, as a staff we have reviewed and revised our policy concerning electronic devices on campus. Our cell phone policy has not changed. Students are allowed to have cell phones on campus but they must remain turned off from 8:15-3:30 and kept in a pocket unless explicitly directed otherwise by a staff member. If you need to contact your student during the school day, please do so through the office. Do not expect to reach your student on their cell phone during school hours and please do not try as it causes distractions to their learning and to the learning of those around them.

To this point, our blanket policy on laptops, iPads/ tablets, and especially iPods/MP3 players is that they are not allowed on campus. This has been changed due to the academic benefit these devices can have under responsible use and certain conditions. Therefore, we are now allowing electronic devices to be on campus at the students' risk. In general, we encourage students to keep such devices at home as they run the risk of damage or theft at school. However, students may only use electronic devices within a classroom setting, under the direct supervision and explicit direction of a teacher for an identified educational purpose, and according to each teacher's classroom policies. Electronic devices will be confiscated for use outside of these parameters. If an electronic device is confiscated, a parent will need to pick it up and the student may be banned from bringing such a device back to school.

CA High School Exit Exam Coming Up

The California High School Exit Exam will be administered during the school day on March 13 (English language arts) and 14 (mathematics) to all 10th graders. 11th and 12th graders who have not yet passed either the English language arts or the mathematics portions will take the portion(s) they still need to pass on these dates as well. Please plan for your student(s) to be in school on these days if they are scheduled to take one or both of these exams.

Order Your AP Exams Before the Deadline

Parents of AP students, it is time to pay for AP exams so they can be ordered. All students enrolled in AP classes are required to take the corresponding AP exam administered in May. Students who do not qualify for the free/reduced lunch program owe \$79 per AP exam. Students who do qualify for the free/reduced lunch program owe \$15 for each of their first three AP exams and \$53 for each AP exam after their third. Please make checks payable to Liberty Charter High School. If a student is taking one AP class, they owe for one exam. If a student is enrolled in three AP classes, they owe for three AP exams. The deadline to order AP exams is April 4. Please turn in the exam fee(s) for your student as soon as possible before the April 4 deadline. Fees should be turned in to your student's AP teacher. If your student is enrolled in multiple AP classes, they can turn in one check for all their fees to just one of their AP teachers. Cash is also accepted.
